Online training sessions led by an International Rescue Committee (IRC) education specialist (Fully funded by IRC - Registered Charity)

The Healing Classroom training consists of 3 online sessions which will provide you with an opportunity to learn about the Healing Classrooms model and to share expertise with other colleagues in Hertfordshire. Each session will last roughly 1 hour and will take place on Tuesday 18th April, 25th April, 2nd May at 4:00pm. Once registered, IRC will send you a Healing Classrooms educator handbook in the post, this will be required during the sessions.

Online Trauma informed practice workshop led by an International Rescue Committee (IRC) education specialist. (Fully funded by IRC)

Crisis and conflict have direct and profound effects on children's physical safety, wellbeing and ability to learn. This training will explore the causes, consequences, and ways to support students (at the individual and organisational level) to cope and overcome trauma, toxic stress and thrive in their new school.
