Meetings are offered on a first come first serve basis and we don't have capacity to offer further slots once they are booked up. Dear SENCo/Head teacher,

Re: Speech and Language Therapy SENCo meetings

Every school in Hertfordshire has access to a single point of contact for our service with a dedicated email address linked to a small cluster of local schools. Each cluster of schools has named Therapists and Assistants overseeing this email address. Your SLT links are able to discuss children you are considering a referral for; children on SLT caseload; and training requests. We hope you have found access to this dedicated point of contact useful.

Whilst you can still contact your team at any time using the email address, all schools will twice a year, be able to book a meeting with their link Therapist. These meetings will be offered virtually via Attend Anywhere. These meetings provide an opportunity to discuss children who are either not currently on caseload or are waiting for intervention. The Therapist can answer questions, give advice, and direct you to resources and/or advise if a referral is needed. For the children in your school with a named Therapist you will still need to contact the named Therapist seeing them.

After a successful rollout, we are continuing to use the online booking process which allows schools to book, cancel, and reschedule their appointments. Schools will have the ability to book a preferred slot at a time which suits them. You will be provided a QR code & webpage link (specific to your school cluster) to enable you to book your appointments. You will be asked to register once as part of the first-time registration process. Once you have registered, you will only be asked to login when revisiting the site, so please make a note of your username and password.

We will not be able to offer any alternatives to the dates/times shown via the system. Please be aware that any nominated staff member from the school can attend the meeting on SENCo's/your school's behalf. If you cannot attend the meetings offered this term, please feel free to email your link with your queries and they will aim to get back to you within 10 working days.
