### **Provision Panel**

Headteachers were sent an email on 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2023 outlining the new provision panel process and provided with a number of documents to support requests for specialist provision. Please make sure you are aware of this information. It will be going on the grid over half term. It is important to note that when requesting provision, you must ensure the parents request for type of provision AND named schools they wish to be consulted with is provided at the point at which you ask for special provision. Special schools will be consulted prior to the child's case being presented to panel.

#### Supporting Independent Learning (for primary pupils with SEND)

- 1 Session at Woodfield School Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2023, 1:30-3:30pm
- Develop your understanding of what makes pupils prompt or adult dependent and inhibits independence
- •Understand that interdependence comes before independence
- •Be clear that if the learning is to be independent then the task needs to be easy and within their skill and knowledge repertoire
- Understand the need for knowledge of the pupils current skills and next steps
- •Develop awareness of different approaches, strategies, resources and structures that aid independence including modelling and backward chaining

# My Teen Brain Training Dates for Professionals Working with Teens - 2023/2024

My Teen Brain focuses on a key stage of brain development and shows how changes in the adolescent brain, in conjunction with experience and environment, can affect emotions, relationships, behaviours, sleep and attitudes to risk.

The initiative aims to raise awareness and provide practical information and strategies to professionals. This training along with a range of resources, will enable you to support young people through this time of change.

Professionals working with young adolescents (10-15) and/or their families are invited to attend a free one-day multi-agency training which will look at changes to the adolescent brain, risks and behaviours and how the learning can help a strengthbased approach to practice.
