Services for Young People is running an exciting programme of free holiday activities during the Easter 2024 school holidays. The activities are for young people aged 13-16, including those with special educational needs and disabilities, who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals.

Supporting young people's physical and mental health

The activities focus on healthy lifestyles. Young people will have the opportunity to:

- Take part in fun physical activities such as sports, dance and team games
- Get creative with arts and crafts, music production and cooking
- Meet and socialise with other young people
- Get free healthy food every day

Join informal healthy lifestyles workshops on:

- healthy food choices and cooking
- emotional wellbeing and resilience
- staying safe
- healthy relationships
- keeping active
- smoking, drug and alcohol awareness
- stress and sleep awareness

Young people will also find out about other services available to them in their area, including SfYP's term-time projects for young people.

The activities will take place during the Easter holidays, from Tuesday 2 to Friday 5 April 2024, with each session lasting four hours a day. These activities will be held in all areas of Hertfordshire.

There are 20 spaces per district and the allocation of places is on a first come, first served basis.
